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


The success of your treatment

may depend in part on how well you use your time with the surgeon:

- Don't be afraid to ask questions and voice your concerns to your surgeon
- Be prepared to talk about your medical history
- Make a list of all the medications you're taking
- Mention any allergies you may have
- Tell your surgeon about activities you have limited or given up, such as walking or stair climbing

Here are some questions you may want to ask during your visit:

- Can knee/hip replacement surgery help relieve my pain and stiffness?
- What type of knee/hip replacement do you think is appropriate for my situation?
- How many of this type of procedure do you typically perform in a year?
- Who will manage my medical conditions? For example, diabetes or heart?
- What are the benefits and risks of knee/hip replacement surgery?
- Am I a candidate for robotic surgery?
- Am I a candidate for knee/hip replacement surgery in an outpatient setting? Why or why not?
- How will my pain be managed after surgery?
- How long does recovery and rehabilitation take after surgery, and what can I expect?
- Will you help set me up with physical therapy after my surgery?
- What activities could I participate in after I recover?
